

The Training Approval Scheme (TAS) is a quality mark for training courses in restorative practice for facilitators. It was piloted with 18 restorative training courses and launched in January 2016.

The TAS has now been replaced by the new Training Provider Quality Mark (TPQM) and is no longer open for applications.
